People often ask, “Who is your typical client?”. The truth is, there isn’t a “typical” client. Other than the common link of having a pregnancy issue, the demographics cover a wide spectrum and have a wide variety of implications relative to their pregnancy. They all have different family dynamics that come into play during their pregnancy, different spiritual and religious beliefs, and practices. Some are single, some are married, some are abortion minded, many are abortion vulnerable. They may welcome the pregnancy, are surprised by the pregnancy, or are in denial that they are even pregnant. While a large percentage of clients are either uninsured or under-insured, most don’t feel confident in their situation and/or are unsure of their ability to be a parent. Therefore, “typical” isn’t easily defined.

An easier question would be, “How do you help women at Path?”. We welcome her, provide a place for her to unburden herself, and remind her that she isn’t alone. We can be someone who points out her value, her worth, and her ability to navigate difficult situations. We’re committed to help our clients find solutions: education programs, personal support, professional counseling services, or other things they may need to walk a new path towards a better life with their child.

Of course, we are here to remind women they can choose life for their babies, but as the world, society and our economy changes, the needs go far beyond the abortion minded or abortion vulnerable women. What never changes at Path is the opportunity to help improve the lives of our clients. That is truly our focus. By making a difference in the mom’s life, we have a direct impact on the baby’s life. Additionally, we also can allow all of our clients to see their value as a mom; the fathers to see their value as a dad; and the importance of a strong, healthy family. The end goal is to walk with them on their path to becoming successful, loving Godly families.
