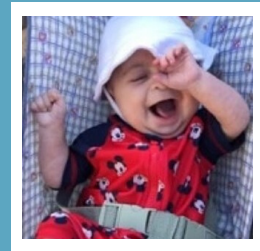
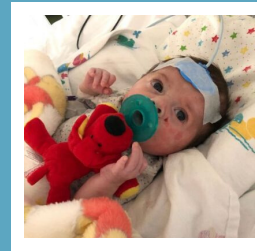
HELP US RAISE FUNDS
