Data from 2021 shows that just over 2,000 women chose abortion in Idaho. Now more than ever, women facing unplanned pregnancies need a safe and trusted place to turn. Path wants to be that place, and help women answer the question, "What's Next?"

The time for the faith-based community to get involved is now, and together we must answer the same question.

What's next, and how can we work together to support women and families throughout their pregnancy and beyond? Changing the hearts and minds of the next 2,000 women who may be considering abortion is something only God can do. What Path, and other life affirming organizations can do, is make sure they have somewhere to turn when the journey before them is unexpected and uncertain.

We also need to build the infrastructure that will be necessary to support women who choose to parent or make an adoption plan. Regardless of their decision, it's not an easy choice. We are only one piece of the puzzle and need to work with others who are called to this shared vision of the future.

We wrapped up summer here at Path with a fun day in the sun with youth from Epworth Chapel on the Green.

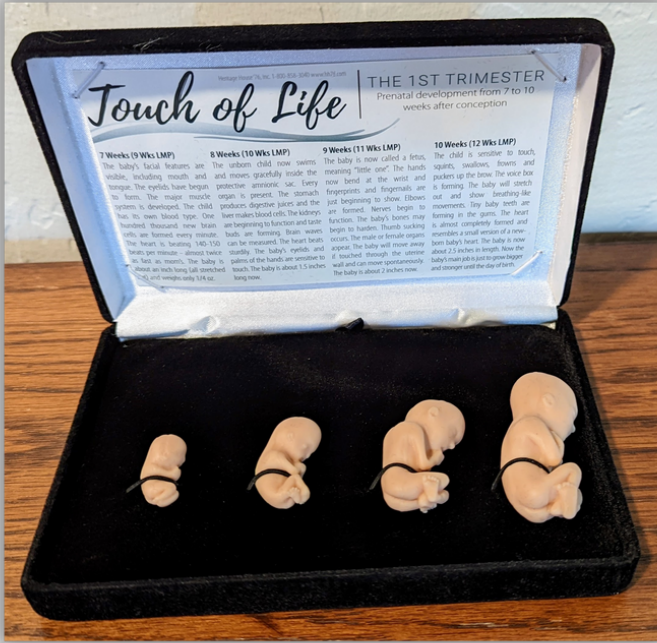
